Keeping You Safe. Please remember to fill up church from the front and take the next "available space". Please do not mix with people outside our household or "bubbles", or wander about in church, for whatever reason before, during or after the service. A condition of our risk assessment and our ability to remain open is that we do not gather for chat either before or after the service in either the church or the churchyard.

If you don't have an email address yourself it is possible to give details of someone else who would be willing to accept this on your behalf and forward it to you.
